The USCID/Summers Engineering Scholarship Fund was endowed by a generous contribution from the late **Joseph B. Summers**, founder of Summers Engineering, Inc., Hanford, California. Since the Fund was established in 1989, it has been supplemented annually by contributions from USCID Members.

The \$1,000 Scholarship is awarded annually to an upper division undergraduate or master's degree students with a demonstrated interest in agricultural engineering, irrigation and drainage, agricultural water management. Only USCID Student Members are eligible to apply for the Scholarship.
